Based on the testimony and evidence presented for Sec. 125-475(i), the Board determined the Respondent remains in violation, and imposed a fine of \$250 per day starting on August 24, 2022 until compliance is achieved. The Board ordered the Respondent to properly fence and secure the swimming pool within 10 days from the Order. If Respondent fails

to do so, the Town may abate the Code violation by taking all reasonable actions to fence and secure the swimming pool.

12. Board Comments, Suggestion and Updates

Upon Chair Hughes' request, the Town Attorney provided an update on the status of the liens at 7011 Haden Road. He also discussed past litigation involving the property.

Motion by Vice Chair Sanchez requesting the Town Council to pursue enforcement of the liens due to the continuing unsanitary conditions at the property, seconded by Board Member Materio; Motion approved (6-0).

The Board also discussed the proposed trailer ordinance and moratorium. Chair Hughes and Vice Chair Sanchez were concerned about the moratorium and wish the Town Council approves a new ordinance as soon as possible so the moratorium stops. Board Member Hernandez would like the Code Enforcement Board to be involved in drafting ordinances. The Recording Clerk suggested that the Board Members express their concerns and suggestions at the next Town Council Meeting.
