On December 6, 2023, the Board found the Respondent in violation of Sec. 34-19(9)(b), and the Respondent must come into compliance by January 24, 2024, or a fine of \$50.00 per day may be imposed until compliance is achieved. The Board stated that compliance may be achieved by either repairing, re-surfacing, or replacing the existing paved area/driveway or by removing the paved

area/driveway and replacing it with sod and irrigate. During the January 24, 2024 Code Enforcement Board Hearing, the Board imposed a fine of \$50.00 per day commencing on January 24,2024 until compliance is achieved. As of the date of this hearing, the total fine amount due is \$4,600.00, plus administrative costs to record the lien.
