He noted that CRA Budget is included in the Town budget and since the Town is still going through the audit process, CRA revenues and expenditures are unaudited at this time. He noted sixteen (16) new businesses opened within the CRA and that two (2) business expanded their services. He also noted that twenty (20) building permits were issued within the CRA.
