AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CLARKE SHORES, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 125-767. "PARKING SPECIFIED VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS", DIVISION 8. "MOBILE HOMES. TRAILERS.
